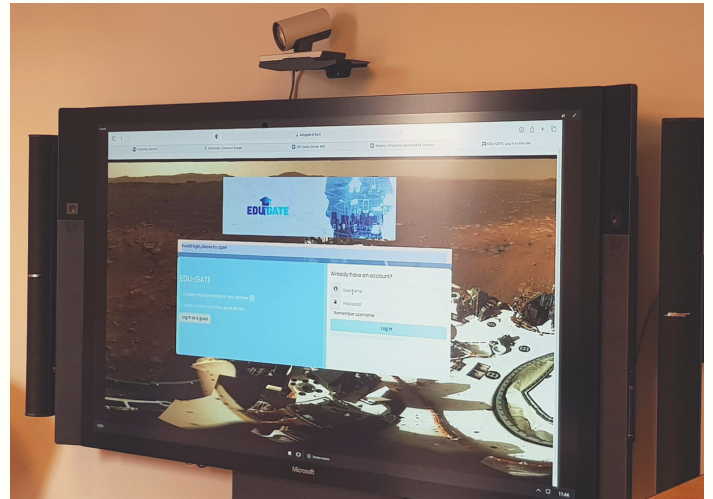


A SNEAK PEEK INTO THE EDU-GATE ONLINE PLATFORM...
