## 2nd Partner Meeting in Thessaloniki, Greece



On 17 and 18 May, 2022 it was held the 2nd face-to-face partner meeting in Thessaloniki, Greece hosted by the partner University of Macedonia. During the two-day meeting the consortium partners discussed important topics related to project management, development of Intellectual outputs and project results. Special sessions were dedicated to each of the project's results, including the Online Training Curriculum of IO2, the E-learning integrated platform of IO3, and the Learning modules, which are part of IO4. Additionally, partners discussed the dissemination activities planned for the following months.



## Result 1: Multi-sectoral analysis reports



## Result 4: Learning contents, classroom guidelines and skills assessment tools

Partners are actively working on developing 12 multimedia e-modules of tutorial-style content. The topics include: use of educational videos and interactive platforms, creation of online assignments and quizzes, selection of online educational resources. The main objective of Result 4 is to create a professional online course that is intended for developing and improving HEI staff skills in the use of strategies and tools for blended and online education.



## Result 2: Online training curriculum

The online training curriculum includes a methodology for development and delivery of learning contents, experiential knowledge and skills assessment tools.

The objective of the Curriculum is to:

- (1) Investigate and analyze the state of the art of digitization and innovative automation practices in the partner countries.
- (2) Provide a context analysis of the innovation in education practices.
- (3) Identify the needs and requirements of the target groups of the participants.
- (4) Identify best practices in each partner country.
- (5) Provide guidelines that would assist teachers and educators.

In order to collect the most relevant information and data partners conducted an extensive literature review as well as, prepared questionnaires for different target groups in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) that include students, teachers, other staff members and external companies. The respondents were from various higher educational institutions in Italy, Greece, Latvia, and Bulgaria.
