## Brief description of the program

### *Summary of the DD@S project*

The DD@S project is presented in brief. You'll get a clear view on the theme and project results, beginning with the results of the DD@S survey, the focus group results that led to the teacher modules and eventually the training platform.

### *Presentation DD@S training platform*

The training platform is presented. Participants are guided through the different components of the training platform, the modules and exercises. Each participant can register freely and start using the platform.

### *Learning communities on controversial themes*

These workshops provide a framework and good practices to work with pupils on controversial topics. Each participant can participate in two different workshops out of four themes: political topics, gender, vulnerable groups and religious topics.

### *Educational walk*

Get to know some interesting places in Brussels and see them from an educational perspective. This walk brings you to De Foyer vzw, an organization representing the interests of Brussels' citizens from an intercultural perspective. You'll also visit Boekelberg, the library of Koekelberg, a community of Brussels. The host will tell you about the political landscape, how this is reflected in Brussels' education and the initiatives that foster a more inclusive educational climate for pupils of both French and Dutch speaking communities. A visit to the Basiliek of Koekelberg, a 19<sup>th</sup> century Art Deco church, and one of the icons of Brussels. And off course, you also get to visit the school of our partner KA Zavelenberg and get to know their work and educational setting in Brussels.

### *Learning communities: closing activity*

In this closing activity, participants get to know the learning community online. In a speed dating format, participants drop ideas in the online community, meet each other in real person and then discuss their input together. This is the final activity and contributes to a sustainable platform about the DD@S project results.
