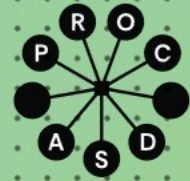

Why PROC-ASD?

Did you know that while 7 million people in Europe are on the autism spectrum, fewer than 10% are employed?

We believe that having at least 5 million unemployed people is a huge opportunity that we're not taking advantage of. Many adults with autism have incredible natural talents, like attention to detail and spotting patterns, that fit perfectly to the ICT sector. PROC-ASD project bridges this gap by creating a more inclusive path from education to employment.

Our two-way solution

1. For learners on the autism spectrum, we are developing a specialized coding and ICT curriculum designed to match their strengths and learning style.
2. For ICT educators, we are designing a training framework to help them adapt their courses to be inclusive for neurodivergent learners.

4. Raising awareness in employers to build an inclusive workforce.

Discover the benefits of hiring neurodivergent talent and how to support them.

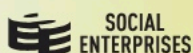
